



The conference will open on Wednesday evening, March 9th with an exhibition of photographs of the Mexican Revolution, the Punitive Expedition, and the new technology deployed in the campaign in Mexico. The Arizona History Museum is hosting this opening conference event in conjunction with the Old Primero Historical Foundation of Abilene, Texas. The Wednesday evening event will conclude with the premiere of a new documentary film on the Columbus raid and the subsequent American military operations in northern Mexico, *Patton and Pancho: A Clash of Cultures*.

The documentary includes the analysis of both American and Mexican historians, important contemporary motion picture film footage of the times, and significant newly uncovered images taken on both sides of the combat trail.
